

LVI Careers Day

This day will include 3 main sessions: the Practical Jobhunting workshop, Networking and its importance and a series of talks from returning OEs on life in the workplace, followed by Q&A.

The Practical Jobhunting workshop will take students through the nuts and bolts of sitting down and applying for work. The main focus areas will be:

1. Choosing a job - helping students identify the right industry, company and individual role for them
2. Finding a job - Where and how to look for opportunities with practical advice and lists
3. Getting that job – A step-by-step exploration of the key stages of every application and how to tackle them

Students should gain:

- Initial ideas about their career path
- Fluency in the language of jobhunting, from job specs to key terms
- An understanding of the importance of networking and a contact book
- Knowledge of where to look for jobs and a starter list of industry-specific sites
- Experience of researching a company in support of applications
- Detailed exploration of CVs, cover letters, application forms and interviews
